More than 160 years of history (the Technical School for Engineers was founded in 1859)





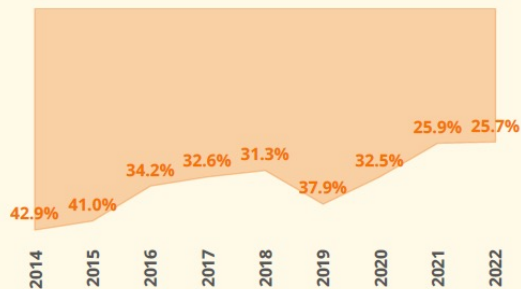

**DIST department** is the point of reference for Turin's Polytechnic and University in the cultural areas dealing with **spatial transformation** and **spatial governance processes**.

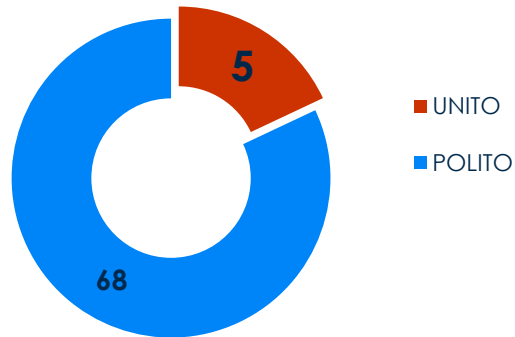

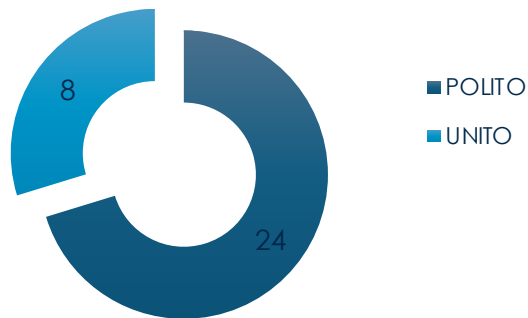

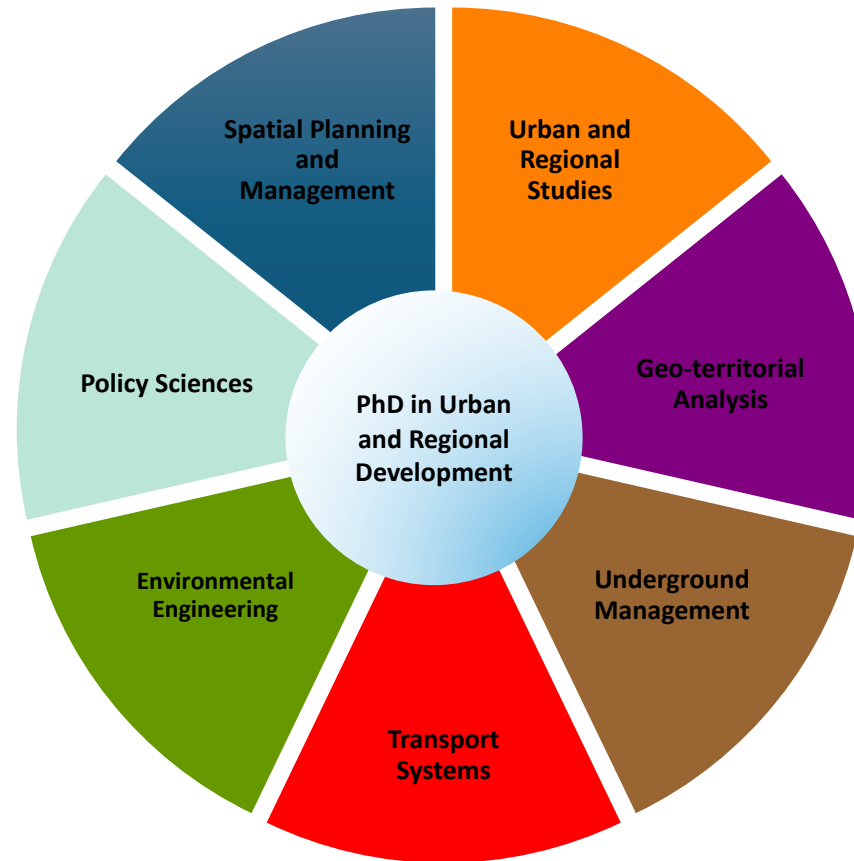
